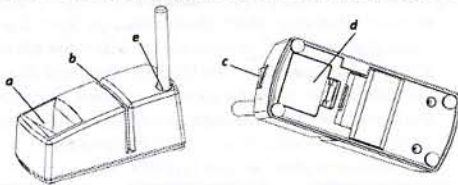


IDETECTOR INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE



a) viewing chamber b) document slot c) toggle switch uv / white
d) battery compartment e) pen holder

Install 3 AAA batteries in the compartment located in the bottom of the unit. We recommend alkaline batteries for best performance.

Counterfeit Detection for Currency

US Currency:

There are 3 tests for US currency in this package.

- Paper Test.** The first is a test for authentic US currency paper. Make a small mark on any US bill with the enclosed Counterfeit Detector Pen. If the mark is yellow or gold the money passes the test. If the mark turns dark, the currency is suspect.

- Watermark Test.** All US paper money has a watermark portrait of the president that appears on that denomination. This is located on the far right side of the bill. To see this, switch on the IDetector so that the white light is on. Slide the bill into the slot, look into the mirrored viewer and locate the watermark portrait. It should closely resemble the printed portrait on the front. Note that the \$1.00 bill does not have a watermark portrait.

- Ultra Violet Test.** Denominations \$5 through \$100 have a micro-printed strip which glows under UV light. Use the illustration below to locate the strip. Insert the bill into the IDetector and switch on the UV light. On good US currency the strip should glow the appropriate color. Then toggle the switch over to white light, and observe the micro printing on the strip. It will have "USA" and the denomination after. ie: USA TWENTY.

IMPORTANT NOTES FOR COUNTERFEIT DETECTION!!

- For the \$100 bill. The UV security strip can be very faint, especially \$100 bill, but also on older \$10s and \$50s. Use the white light to check the micro-printing and location of the strip to verify these bills. If the strip glows a different color, or is in a different location, the bill is probably counterfeit. Recently, counterfeiters have been bleaching \$5 bills and overprinting as a \$100. This can be easily detected with your IDetector by noting the location and color of the strip.
- The UV security strips vary in intensity from bill to bill. They are more consistent in the most recent colorful \$10s, \$20s and \$50s. If you have doubts about a particular bill, use all 3 tests!

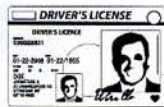
International Currencies:

Euro: Use the UV feature of your IDetector to spot the colorful UV sensitive fibers located throughout the currency paper

Canadian Dollar: Use the UV feature to see the words "Bank Of Canada" located directly on the portrait on the front of the note.

DOCUMENT AUTHENTICATION



Driver's Licenses: The UV properties associated with licenses vary by state. More than two-dozen state licenses contain UV sensitive features in the laminate, which will glow under the UV light setting of your IDetector. New York, California, Texas and Florida currently have UV features. Obtain a recent license in your state to test for UV security features.

Resident Alien / Green Cards: If authentic, depending on the year of issue, either "USA" or and image of the U.S. flag will glow under the UV feature of your IDetector.

Passports: US Passports of recent issue have the image of an eagle glowing under UV light at 4 places on the interior pages, and in the center of the photo page. Most other passports have UV features as well.

Travelers Cheques: Most travelers cheques, including American Express, have UV features.

Money Orders: Most money orders include UV security features.

Battery replacement: The IDetector uses 3 AAA batteries, which should last for weeks of constant usage. Be sure to turn the unit off when not in use. Use alkaline batteries for best performance.

CREDIT CARDS



Visa: A dove will appear in the center of the card under UV light

Mastercard: The initials MC will appear, usually near the bottom of the card

American Express: The initials AMEX will appear across the face of green, gold, and platinum cards. AM EX will appear across the top of Amex blue card. Signature tapes on the back may also have UV features.

Discover: The word DISCOVER appears across the front.

Diners Club: A letter "D" appears in the center.

UV MARKINGS ON DRIVERS LICENSES

The IDetector is ideal for authenticating Driver's Licenses. New states will be added as available. Look for the following markings:

| State | Description of UV Markings |
|----------------|---|
| Alabama | State Seal across front |
| California | Small image of Bear on front |
| Connecticut | On back license, a picture of the state |
| Florida | On new issue licenses, UV picture of licensee in blank area in the lower right corner, next to the visible picture. |
| Georgia | No UV markings |
| Indiana | State flag emblem on front |
| Iowa | Name of licensee on front of license at the bottom |
| Kentucky | "The Bluegrass State" across front |
| Maryland | "Maryland" written across front |
| Mississippi | State seal on front in the center |
| New Jersey | UV picture of licensee lower right corner |
| New York | State seal across center |
| North Carolina | No UV markings |
| Ohio | No UV markings |
| Oklahoma | State seal on front at the top center |
| Pennsylvania | "Pennsylvania" written in cursive on back |
| South Carolina | No UV markings |
| Tennessee | No UV markings |
| Utah | "UT" across front |
| Virginia | No UV markings |
